



ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE COURSE DESCRIPTION

Reading and Comprehension Skill I

This is an introductory Reading and Comprehension Course where focus is on the skills required to read and comprehend basic English texts for the elementary students who are non-native speakers of the English language. Various reading techniques such as skimming, scanning, sequencing, finding similarities and comprehension skills such as inferring and summarizing are introduced to prepare student at CEFR A1-A2 level.

Listening, Speaking and Pronunciation I

This is an introductory Listening, Speaking and Pronunciation Course where focus is on the skills required for oral communication in various daily living situations. Learning strategies such as short informal discussions, using every day vocabulary and student also practice listening and responding to simple instruction are used to prepare student at CEFR A1-A2 level.

Writing, Grammar and Vocabulary Development I

This is an introductory Writing, Grammar and Vocabulary Development Course where focus is on the skills to structure sentence, punctuation and grammar to develop writing competency. After learning this course student is able to write and organize paragraphs, use basic form and function of grammatical structure and is able to apply them in speaking, listening and writing activities. This course prepare student at CEFR A1-A2 level.

Communicative Competence

This course introduces the student to communicative competence which includes the grammatical competence, socio-linguistic, discourse, and strategic competence. The Aim of this course is to develop spoken English proficiency to negotiate various scenarios where interaction in second language is an expected part of daily life.

Reading and Comprehension Skill II

This is an intermediate Reading and Comprehension Course which builds upon the Reading and Comprehension Skill I and focus is on the skills required to read and understand short messages, written instructions, simple forms, tables, schedules, directories, and short texts. Various combination of techniques such as explanations, demonstrations, tasks, and reading and writing assignments are used to prepare student at CEFR B1-B2 level.



Listening, Speaking and Pronunciation II

This is an intermediate Listening, Speaking and Pronunciation Course which builds upon the Listening, Speaking and Pronunciation I and focus is on the skills required for oral communication in various daily living situations and presentation. Learning strategies such as role play, presentations, simulations and assignments using every day vocabulary are used and student also practice listening and topic specific language are to prepare student at CEFR B1-B2 level.

Writing, Grammar and Vocabulary Development II

This is an intermediate Writing, Grammar and Vocabulary Development Course which builds upon the Writing, Grammar and Vocabulary Development I and where focus is on the skills required for writing process, complex sentence structures, basic paragraph patterns of organization, punctuation, and editing. After learning this course student is able to write and organize paragraphs, use difficult grammatical structure and is able to apply them in writing activities. This course prepare student at CEFR B1-B2 level.

Canadian Perspectives

This course designed to use the four skills of English to explore the different aspects of the society in Canada in class, including a focus on indigenous cultures. By practising various comprehensions of specific aspects of Canadian life students will strengthen their skills and ability to interact with the Canadian people in various environments.

Reading and Comprehension Skill III

This is an advanced Reading and Comprehension Course which builds upon the Reading and Comprehension Skill II and focus is on the skills required to understand moderately complex and abstract texts on various social and academic topics. Various combination of techniques such as explanations, demonstrations, tasks, and reading and writing assignments are used to prepare student at CEFR C1-C2 level.

Listening, Speaking and Pronunciation III

This is an advanced Listening, Speaking and Pronunciation Course which builds upon the Listening, Speaking and Pronunciation II and focus is on the skills required for oral communication in various social and academic situations and be able to express in formal and informal settings in daily living, social and academic topics. Learning strategies such as explanations, listening and speaking presentations, demonstrations, tasks, simulations and discussions are used and students also practice note taking skills and participate in longer conversations to prepare them at CEFR C1-C2 level.

Writing, Grammar and Vocabulary Development III

This is an advanced Writing, Grammar and Vocabulary Development Course which builds upon the Writing, Grammar and Vocabulary Development I and where focus is on the skills required for brain storming and mind mapping techniques writing projects, and apply higher level of vocabulary and grammatical structure in academic writings. After learning this course student is able to write complex sentence structure and are able to structure essay. This course prepare student at CEFR C1-C2 level.
